# GHANA

Ghana is the UK's fourth largest export market in sub Saharan Africa. Ghana has strong economic, historical and political connections with the UK. It is a member of the World Trade Organization (WTO).

Several British businesses have traded in the market for over 100 years. New entrants are at the forefront of the oil, financial and telecommunication sectors. Some of the well-known businesses include Barclays, Standard Chartered, Vodafone, Tullow, Blue Skies, British Airways, G4S and Prudential.

Ghana's economy has maintained an average annual growth of about 6% over the past 6 years. In 2013 growth slowed to 4.4%, considerably lower than the 7.9% achieved in 2012.

However, growth has been largely driven by service oriented sectors and industry. These have been growing at an average rate of 9% over the 5 years up to 2013.
